What are the expressive qualities of line?

vertical
lines

go up and down, they're static. short → tall

horizontal
lines

make us feel as though we're on solid ground

Curved
lines

express activity; can change direction; depending on the curve the expression changes; they're hypnotic

diagonal
lines

can add tension or create excitement; are either falling or rising. Express instability or activity. Make you uncomfortable

Zig zag
lines

create confusion; extremely active, evoke feelings of excitement and nervousness. The direction effects the intensity. example: lightning

contour line drawing	define the edges of a surface. They create a boundary. Drawn slow and steady without lifting pencil.
gesture drawing	an expressive movement; quick and messy
calligraphy	means beautiful handwriting conveys ideas, objects, sounds thin & thick lines
